Medicine at School

If your student has medicine at school, please remember that it needs to be picked up by an adult by Friday, June 23rd @ 2:00pm unless other arrangements have been made with the school nurse.

Attention Parents of Current 5th Grade Students

The Department of Health wants you to be aware of three immunizations that your child must have before entering 6th grade.

Tdap or Tetanus Diphtheria & Pertussis (Whooping Cough) - Your child must receive a Tdap. Make sure the school has the date of this vaccination.

MMR or Measles, Mumps, Rubella - Prior to kindergarten your child received a second MMR. If your child did not receive this second MMR, a second dose is required before 6th grade.

Varicella or Chickenpox - Your child must receive a Varicella vaccination or have had Chickenpox before entering 6th grade. Verification of the disease must come from a Health Care Provider.

You will be able to view your student's teacher assignment for 2017--2018 in Skyward Family Access on August 30, 2017. We will have class assignments available to view in the main hallway as well. Please do not call the office before that time to ask for your student's class assignment.

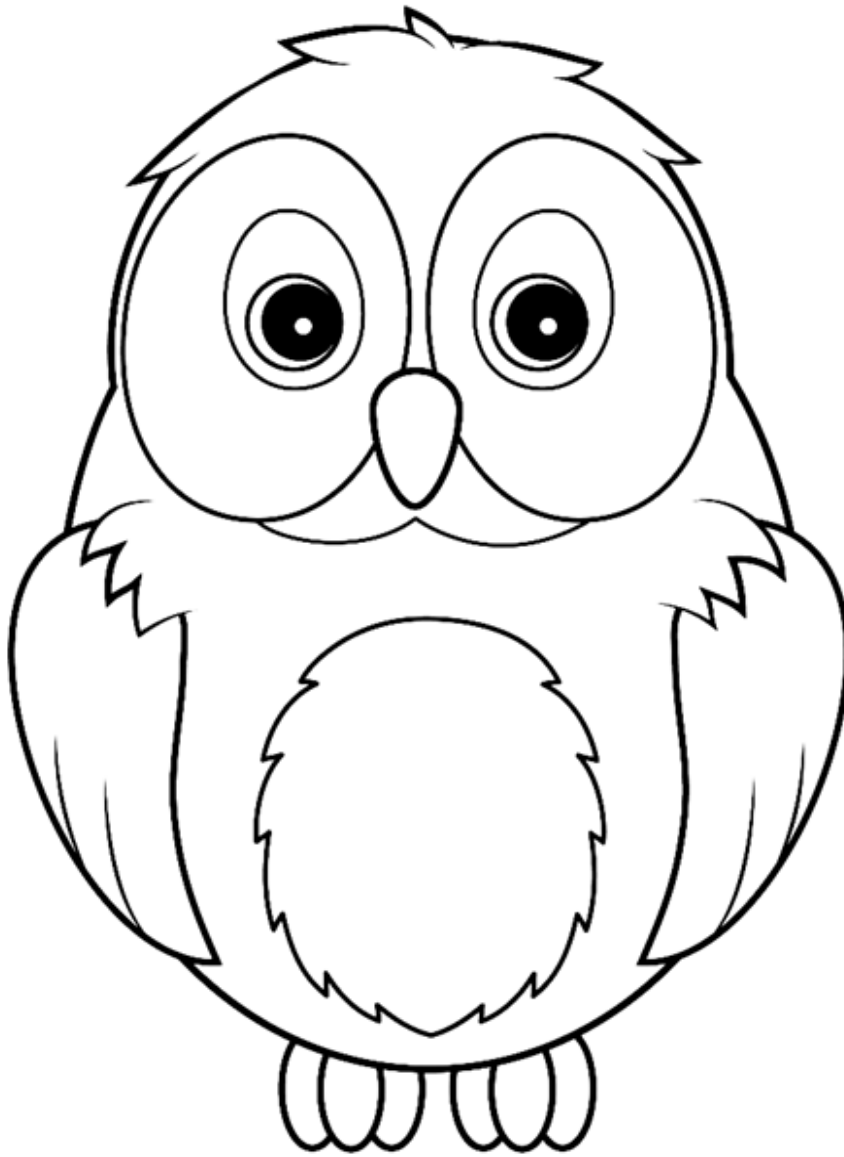
