ATTENDANCE & ABSENCES

Regular attendance is necessary for successful school work. Anytime your child is absent from school, parents are required to call the attendance line at (360) 596-6603 to report the reason your child is not in school. Please try and call before 9:30am. The automated calls on unexcused absences go out at 9:45am. The attendance line is a 24 hour voicemail number that you can call anytime; or send a note to the teacher/office explaining the reason for your child's absence the next day. A student is marked unexcused if they are absent from school, and the office does not receive a phone call or email the day of the absence, OR if there was no written or verbal notification given to the office prior to the absence, Olympia School District Policies and Procedures Policy 3200 state: When a student reaches 10 or more total unexcused absences during the current school year, the District is required to file a court petition.
